**What is the nature and focus of the courses?** All courses published in the **2019 Prospectus** will take the form of 5-day residential courses (except eSkills4All) addressing teaching content and strategies specific to a particular subject.

**Will trainees be assessed?** Yes – trainees will be assessed in a pre- and post-test related directly to the content of the course to ascertain the impact of the training on their subject knowledge.

**Who should attend?** Subject Advisors / Heads of Department / Teachers responsible for the specific grade/ phase and subject being targeted.

**Why should I attend?** Trainees who completed provincial courses during 2018 had the following to say:

- *I came back with a positive attitude to my subject.*
- *We had the opportunity to share knowledge and grow.*
- *I am confident of what to teach in my class.*
- *I found the setting of papers using Barret's taxonomy very helpful*
- *I learnt how to deal with different ability levels in my class.*
- *I learnt different teaching strategies and how to integrate technology in my lessons.*
- *I gained deeper insight into Organic Chemistry.*
- *We were able to link mathematics and science in the projectile graph.*

**How many can attend?** 1 group of up to 50 trainees per institute for each course listed in the Prospectus for the June/July 2019 school holidays.

**Training at the Nelson Mandela Provincial Teacher Development Institute:** This institute, based in Port Elizabeth, serves the training needs of the Nelson Mandela Metro, Sarah Baartman and Amathole West districts. However, some training may occur at only one or two institutes. In this case, teachers will be trained at the institute nearest to them.

**When are the courses taking place?** During the June/July 2019 school holidays. See the **2019 Prospectus** for course details, including content and venues.
